



## **Two Day Great Ocean Road Tour**

### **Day One – Saturday 17 October**

Depart Melbourne and head to the South Western Victorian Town of Warrnambool for Lunch (own expense). Then it's on to Tower Hill the Sunken Volcano full of Aussie wildlife including Koalas, Kangaroo's and Emus. Check out some aboriginal art and artefacts in the Tower Hill Aboriginal cultural centre.

Then (depending on the time of year) either view the Southern Right Whales migratory path along the southern coast of Australia or stop at cheese world to try the wonderful cheeses on offer.

Its then on the western end of the Great Ocean Road to view the lesser known but just as impressive coastal sights – The Bay of Martyrs, Bay of Island, The Grotto and London Bridge.

After checking into your dorm accommodation (included) it's down to the 12 Apostle to view an amazing sunset at one the 7 Natural wonders of the world. From your vantage point you will watch as the sun fades behind the 12 apostle until an army of Little Penguins come home after a day of fishing out at sea. It's then back to your accommodation for a free Aussie BBQ diner.

### **Day Two – Sunday 18 October**

After Breakfast (included) head down to into Lochard Gorge and hear the tale of the tragic shipwreck. Travel onto the 12 Apostles to view them in the morning sunlight and take a flight over the coast in a helicopter (optional – own expense). Walk down Gibson's Steps and onto the beach for another prospective of these amazing rock formations with the dramatic limestone cliff backdrop.

Leaving the ship wreck coast behind travel through the magnificent Otway Ranges and take a charming walk through a tempered rain forest amongst some of the worlds tallest trees before travelling into the coastal town of Apollo Bay for Lunch (own expense).

After lunch snake and wind along the Great Ocean Road stopping at fantastic look outs and delightful coastal town before arriving at Australia's most famous surfing beach Bell's Beach. Check the huge surf before hading into Australia's surfing capital for some shopping at the huge number of surf shops. Arrive back in Melbourne between 6 & 7pm.
