Wilsons Promontory National Park Day Tour – Saturday 26 September, 2009

Wilsons Promontory is Victoria's natural wonderland. Located at the southernmost point of the Australian mainland, Wilsons Promontory (affectionately known to Victorians as 'the Prom') is arguably the most loved national park in Victoria. Its 130 km coastline is framed by granite headlands, mountains, forests and fern gullies. The park contains the largest coastal wilderness area in Victoria.

Your one day experience will show you all the natural wonders of this amazing National Park. The park has diverse vegetation communities including warm temperate and cool temperate rainforest, tall open forests, woodlands, heath lands, and swamp and coastal communities

Over 30 species of native mammals, not including marine mammals, have been recorded in the park. These include populations of the Long-nosed Potoroo, Swamp Antechinus, White-footed Dunnart, Broad-toothed Rat, Feather-tailed Glider and Eastern Pygmy-possum, as well as the more familiar kangaroos, koalas and wombats.

We will explore the Lilly Park Rainforest, and take a walk along Squeaky Beach, and go bushwalking in the natural wilderness. Your one day tour will take in all the highlights of the 'Prom' and you will need to have a reasonable level of fitness to enjoy the natural wonders on show.
